Program/Tool: TurboTAP

Synopsis: *TurboTAP* (www.TurboTAP.org) is an easy to use, interactive Web portal that provides life-long information and support to transitioning military servicemembers (Active Duty, Guard and Reserve) and their families. It is a single source starting point for accessing key resources needed by servicemembers transitioning on and off of active duty at any point in their military career.

TurboTAP was developed through a collaborative partnership between the Department of Defense, Department of Labor, Department of Veterans Affairs, Department of Education, Small Business Administration, the National Veterans Corporation and the National Guard Bureau. These organizations have integrated their best online tools, information and support services for the benefit of transitioners who are leaving or returning to local communities and civilian sector employment.

Main TurboTAP features include:

- A life-long Individual Transition Planning & Alerts Account System: Keeps transitioners connected to their benefits as they change and as new ones are added
- Downloadable Pre-separation Guide for Active Duty Members and Transition Guide for National Guard and Reserve
- Four helpful checklists: Veterans Benefits, Education, Employment & Relocation
- Employment Hub with links to job boards, a resume writer and job search assistance

Who is eligible: All National Guard, Reserves, Active Duty servicemembers who serve a minimum of 180 continuous days on active duty and their families.
